#### What is Shared Living?

Shared Living is a residential option for individuals with disabilities that provides them the opportunity to live in private family homes with dedicated caregivers. Each individual plays an active role in planning their daily routine and receives services tailored to their needs through LifeStream's clinical team and experienced professionals.

#### **The Home Matching Process**

The relationship between the caregiver and the individual is the key to a successful Shared Living experience. LifeStream ensures that caregivers have the skills needed to support the individuals we serve. The process involves both the individual and their family members in a highly personalized matching process. For many, this is the beginning of a long, and mutually rewarding relationship.

#### **Caregiver Eligibility**

Those providing care must meet the following requirements:

- At least 21 years of age
- Must own or rent a home
- May be married or single
- Must be able to provide personal care
- May be employed elsewhere
