Our core services include:

- Community residences for those needing 24-hour supervision and a greater degree of support
- Services for those living on their own but requiring individualized support to maintain their independence
- Residential options for individuals who cannot safely live alone and want the comfort of a home environment
- Day Support services for adults with disabilities
- Employment & Training programs to assist economically disadvantaged people find and maintain career employment
- Autism services for children and adults
- Services for those with Acquired Brain Injury and Traumatic Brain Injury
- Clinical Services to optimize the health and well-being of the individuals we serve



Clinical Services

LifeStream has a long history of providing an extensive array of services as part of our holistic approach to meeting the needs of those we serve.

Clinical Services include:

- Psychology Services: assessment of emotional and behavioral needs, positive behavior support planning, oversight of psychotropic medications
- Nursing services: close monitoring of health needs, coordination of inpatient and outpatient services
- Occupational Therapy: adaptive equipment, sensory motor development
- Physical Therapy: increasing endurance, gross motor skills, stretching
- Speech Therapy: expressive and receptive communication, augmentative communication, voice output systems, sign language, swallowing evaluation and dysphagia management
- Nutrition Services: individual nutritional consultation, specialized meal and menu planning
